

St. Theresa of Child Jesus Parish, Morigaon

Archbishop Thomas Menampampil erected the parish in 2000. Finding education as one of the important means to raise the standard of the people, the Archdiocese decided to open a school. Hence, on 5 February 2001 an English medium school was started.

In 2003 the Sisters of Charity (SCCG) arrived and opened Infant Mary Convent. Since their arrival they have been rendering service in the parish and school.

Fr. Ishanad served as its first parish priest from 2000 to 2006 and Fr. Joseph Kallikat from 2006 to 2009. Fr. John D'souza has been administering the parish since 2009.

For the last 15 years the parish has been catering to the educational needs of the people around the area. Much more than playing an influential role, it has been enlightening the young minds, paving the way forward to bring about an all round development in the society.
